# Building Project Update

- Three new developments (no homes yet) transferred to under-capacity schools along Linton Hall corridor
  - Reduction from 30-room addition to 10-room addition
    - Details TBD in future Board meetings
- Will continue to require learning cottages until building project is complete

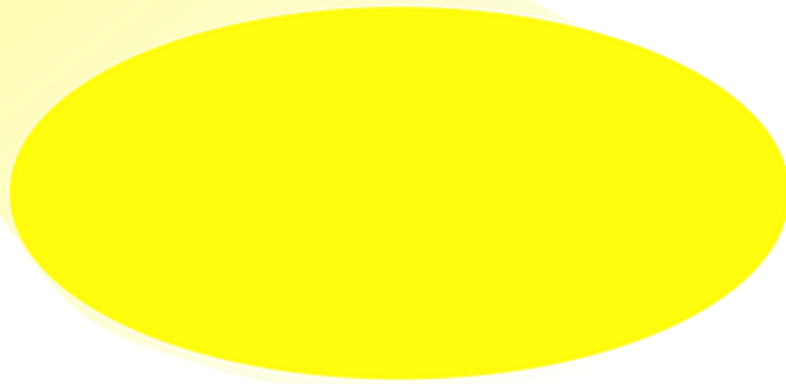

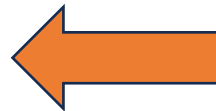
